

ORDINANCE NO. 340

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF FLEETWOOD, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 333, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF FLEETWOOD, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REGULATING THE PRESENCE OF MINORS UNDER THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN (18) YEARS ON THE STREETS OR IN PUBLIC PLACES OR BUSINESS PLACES OF SAID BOROUGH BETWEEN CERTAIN HOURS, AND DEFINING THE DUTIES OF PARENTS AND OTHERS IN THE CARE OF MINORS, AUTHORIZING THE POLICE TO TAKE TEMPORARY CUSTODY OF ANY MINOR VIOLATING THIS ORDINANCE, AND AUTHORIZING THE RETURN OF SAID MINOR TO THE PARENT, GUARDIAN OR OTHER ADULT PERSON HAVING THE LAWFUL CARE AND CUSTODY OF SAID MINOR, PROVIDING FOR ARREST AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE; REPEALING CERTAIN ORDINANCES AND FIXING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE;" BY MODIFYING SECTION 2 THEREOF TO PERMIT MINORS UNDER THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN YEARS BUT OVER THE AGE FIFTEEN YEARS TO BE UPON THE STREETS AND IN PUBLIC PLACES OR BUSINESS PLACES OF THE BOROUGH ON FRIDAYS AND SATURDAYS FROM 5:00 A.M. TO 12:00 O'CLOCK MIDNIGHT; AND REPEALING CERTAIN ORDINANCES.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Fleetwood, situate in Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 333, entitled AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF FLEETWOOD, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REGULATING THE PRESENCE OF MINORS UNDER THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN (18) YEARS ON THE STREETS OR IN PUBLIC PLACES OR BUSINESS PLACES OF SAID BOROUGH BETWEEN CERTAIN HOURS, AND DEFINING THE DUTIES OF PARENTS AND OTHERS IN THE CARE OF MINORS, AUTHORIZING THE POLICE TO TAKE TEMPORARY CUSTODY OF ANY MINOR VIOLATING THIS ORDINANCE, AND AUTHORIZING THE RETURN OF SAID MINOR TO THE PARENT, GUARDIAN OR OTHER ADULT PERSON HAVING THE LAWFUL CARE AND CUSTODY OF SAID MINOR, PROVIDING FOR ARREST AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE; REPEALING CERTAIN ORDINANCES AND FIXING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE,

BE AND THE SAME HEREBY IS, amended to read, as follows:

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of eighteen (18) years, but over the age of fifteen (15) years,



to loiter, loaf or idle on or about any public street, avenue, alley, park or other place, or at any place of amusement, entertainment or refreshment, or other place of business, in the Borough of Fleetwood, on Sundays, Mondays, Tuesday, Wednesdays and Thursdays, between the hours of 10:00 o'clock P.M. and 5:00 o'clock A.M. of the following day, prevailing local time, and on Fridays and Saturdays between the hour of midnight and 5:00 o'clock A.M. of the following day, prevailing local time.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance be, and the same hereby are, repealed insofar, but only insofar, as they are inconsistent herewith.
