ORDINANCE NO. 608

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF FLEETWOOD, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING FOUNDRY ALLEY AS A ONE-WAY STREET BETWEEN SOUTH RICHMOND STREET AND SOUTH FRANKLIN STREET; AND REPEALING CERTAIN ORDINANCES

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Fleetwood, in the County of Berks and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same, in accordance with the provisions of the Act of Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, as follows:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. Foundry Alley, within the Borough of Fleetwood, Berks County, Pennsylvania, from South Richmond Street to South Franklin Street, is hereby made and designated a one-way street, and traffic shall proceed only in a easterly direction on such portion of Foundry Alley.

SECTION 2. No person shall operate a vehicle of any kind in a westerly direction on Foundry Alley from South Franklin Street to South Richmond Street, in the Borough of Fleetwood.

SECTION 3. Directional signs shall be placed at appropriate and convenient locations along Foundry Alley.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar, but only insofar, as they are inconsistent herewith.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days from the enactment of this Ordinance.
