Please expect significant traffic in and through the Borough, especially around the Fleetwood High School Friday night and Saturday for the funeral for the two fallen firefighters from Walnuttown Fire Company. Richmond Street will be posted "No parking" in certain areas Saturday to accommodate the increased traffic. Arch, Maple and Race Streets, near the Fleetwood Park, will also be posted "No Parking" for Saturday.

On behalf of the Fleetwood Borough, we wish to extend our sincere condolences to the family, friends and anyone who knew and loved Chief Buck and Assistant Chief Shick, as well as the Walnuttown Fire Company.
