

FLEETWOOD CHIEF OF POLICE POSITION

Borough of Fleetwood, Berks County, PA, is accepting applications for the position of Chief of Police. The position is a Fair Labor Standards Act - exempt, salaried, non-civil service position.

The successful applicant must possess and maintain valid certification as a police officer under Pennsylvania Act 120 and possess and maintain a valid Pennsylvania driver's license. Salary will be based on experience and qualifications, will include benefits healthcare medical, dental, and vision benefits, paid time off, retirement pension, paid holidays, as well as other benefits.

All applicants must submit a detailed resume of training and experience, and include relevant contact information including daytime phone number.
