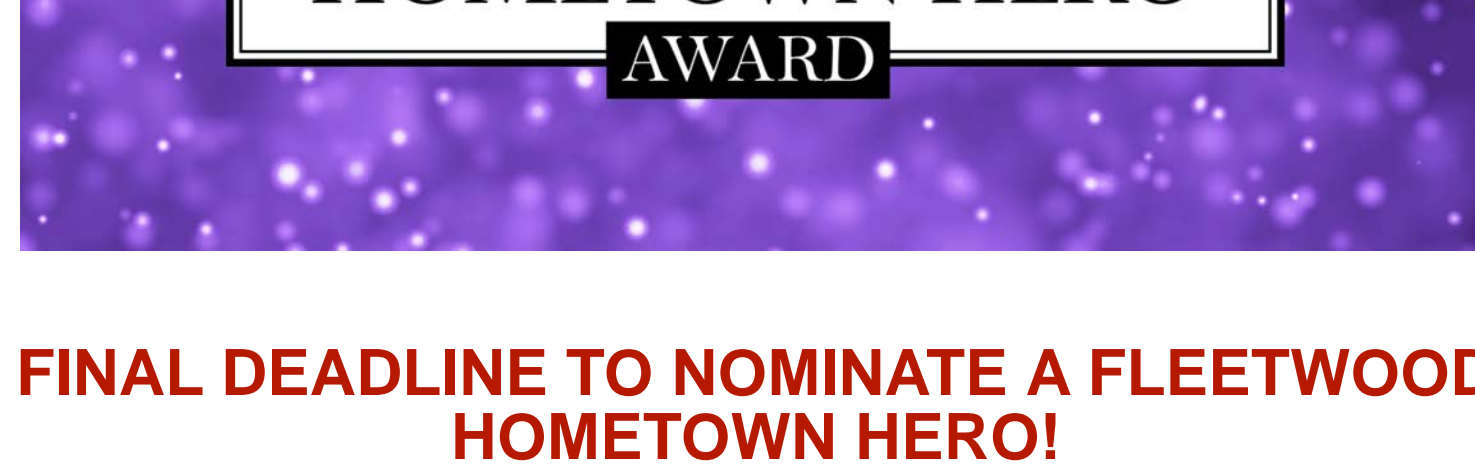

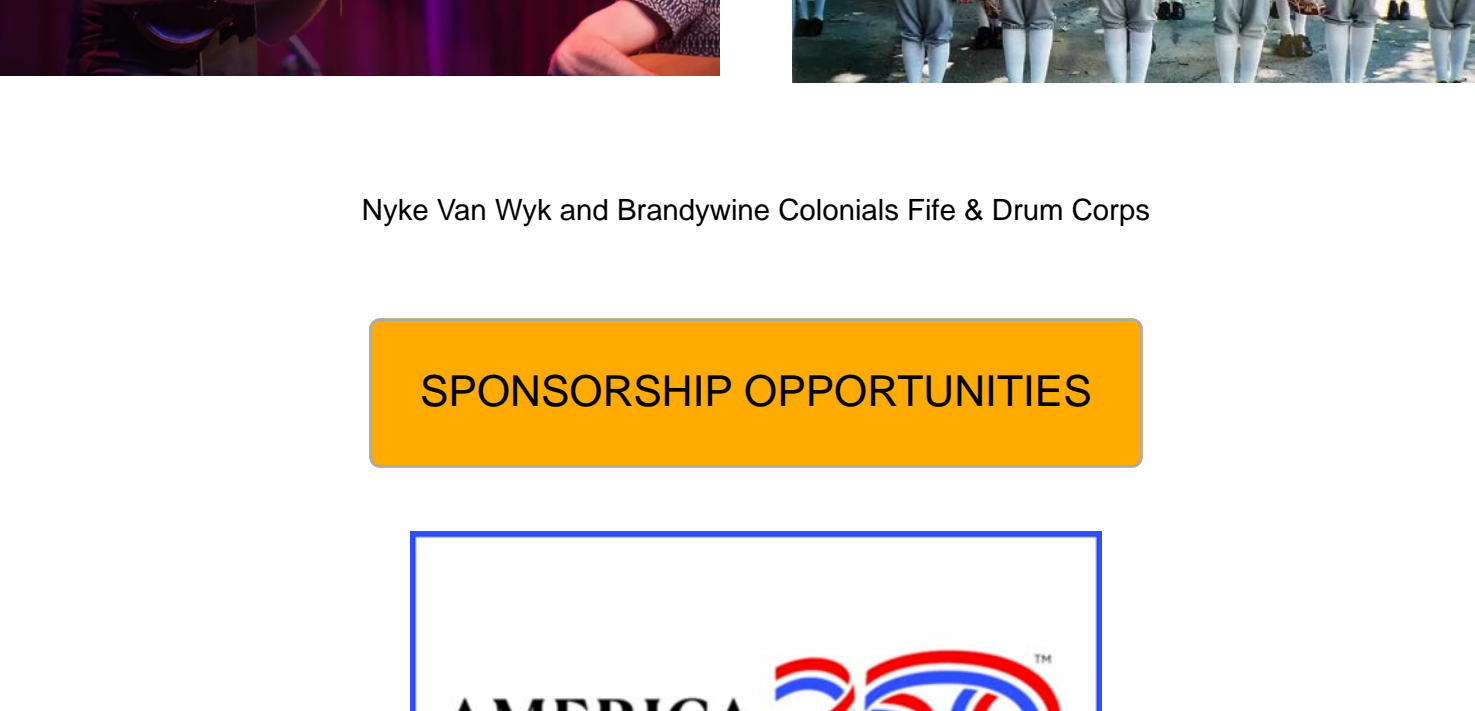


BERKS FIDDLE FEST IS BIGGER, BOLDER AND BETTER THAN EVER!

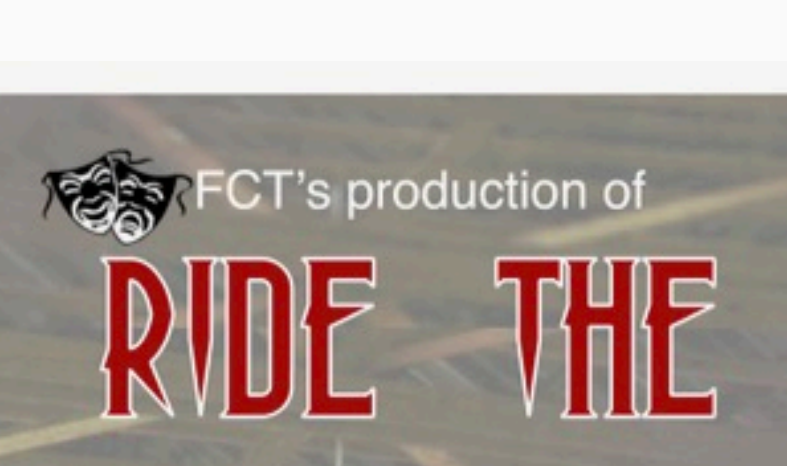

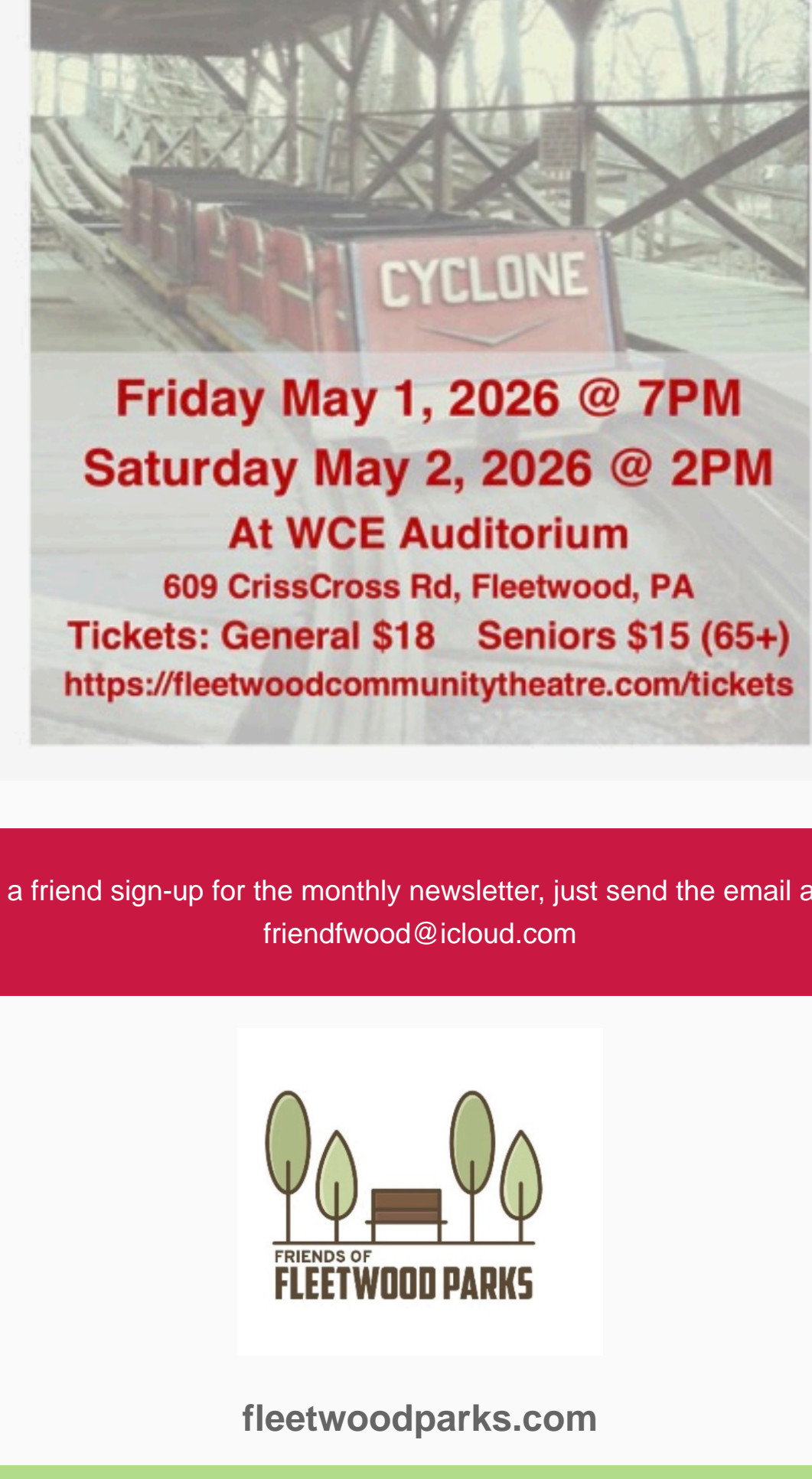

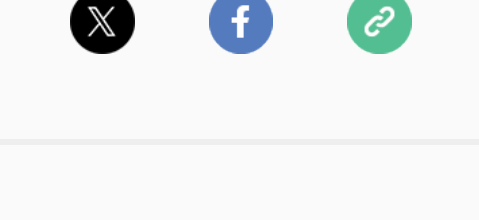
